Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Ken Long and Jeff Rhoads of the Birdsboro Union Fire Department were present to discuss funding for an aerial truck for a cost of \$1.5M with an annual payment of \$106,000. They plan to fundraise and do funding campaigns with residents and businesses. They estimate receiving 45,000 from fundraising, 31,500 from residents, 10,000 from civic and social organizations and 30,000 from businesses. It was requested that the call records be reviewed as it relates to services provided to Birdsboro Borough and Union Township. It was requested that the Fire Department provide incidents and amount of incidents when an aerial truck would be advantageous.

Councilman Myers suggested discussing the Birdsboro Power Agreement during budget discussions.

Council will meet next on October 4, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. to review the draft budget.
